Topic: Providing Clean and Affordable Energy for All – Committee 2

The General Assembly,

Having studied that the use of harmful cooking fuels and methods are leading to around four million premature deaths around the world,

Deeply disturbed that 1st world countries are the major producers of carbon emissions with little clean and renewable sources, even though they are wealthy,

Bearing in mind that about 3% of Afghanistan's households are connected to the national grid,

- 1. Recommends that new cooking fuels/methods like cleaner biomass stoves and liquefied petroleum gas to be implemented around the world;¹
- 2. <u>Reminds</u> first world countries that they do have the funds to use clean energy sources but instead choose not to, and governments could possibly give incentives to use clean energy;²
- 3. <u>Supports</u> funding and resources to help families, specifically women, to gain electricity within their homes.³
