

United Nations Committee: General Assembly

Topic: Ending Forced Labor – Committee 2 **Sponsors:** Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Republic of Poland, and the Federative Republic of Brazil

The General Assembly,

Keeping in mind that there are limited specialized facilities for forced labor victims,

Noting with regret that over 20% of those enclosed in forced labor are unable to be protected or aided by current forced labor actions, as several only regulate the relationships between employers and immigrants, not indigenous persons to Poland,

Having devoted attention to the fact that \$354 billion is being spent on products that are produced by forced labor,

- 1. <u>Calls upon</u> the creation for more specialized facilities for forced labor victims, in order to give said victims more support once they have escaped forced labor;¹
- 2. <u>Further encourages</u> the Polish government to make amendments to the current forced labor prevention laws, which only regulate forced labor for certain persons, and allow for them to become accessible for any human being seeking liberty;²
- 3. <u>Calls upon</u> consumers from all countries to make smart choices on where they are buying their goods so that they are not using forced labor items.³
