

United Nations Committee: General AssemblyTopic: Providing Clean and Affordable Energy for All – Committee 1Sponsors: Republic of India, Czech Republic, French Republic

The General Assembly,

Noting with deep concern that the majority of the places where harmful non-sustainable forms of energy are used for cooking, in which women are more susceptible to harm due to societal norms,

Recognizing that greenhouse gas emitting energy sources is the largest cause of global climate change, being 60% of the contribution,

Guided by the understanding that only 21% of the world's energy consumption comes from clean energy,

- 1. <u>Recommends</u> that countries accelerate the transition to solar cookers, which are ideal for cooking with high temperatures;¹
- <u>Strongly recommends</u> China, India, the United States and other major greenhouse gas contributors to use more renewable energies such as hydro power, geothermal, solar, or other forms of renewables depending on their environment;²
- 3. <u>Further proclaims</u> a boost in the use of clean energy around the world to 50% by 2030 and an initiative to electrify public transportation by 15% by 2025, reducing CO2 emissions.³
