How to Make your Jr. Model UN Video Speech

Step by Step!

Write a 2-3 minute opening speech on your topic from the perspective of your assigned country.



What should be in your speech?

- Your speech should include:
 - Information (facts and statistics)
 regarding your assigned topic
 - How your assigned topic impacts your assigned country (or the world)
 - Why it's important for world leaders to act quickly to solve the issue
 - Offer possible solutions to the issue



Tips for your video

- Remember to use the most relevant information from your research in your video.
- Follow the writing process –
 brainstorm, plan, draft, revise, edit,
 and produce a final product.
- Be clear and concise in your video.



Tips for your video

- Speak slowly and clearly. Make sure to enunciate your words.
- Have other people screen your video before you submit it.
- Be creative. You can use pictures and voice over.



Tips for your Video

- Make sure you follow all of the rules and guidelines, including length, and content
- List all of the sources you used in the end credits
- Have fun and show off your public speaking skills!



When you film your video...

- Make sure you have a good quality camera. You can use an Iphone, android, ipad, or digital camera.
- Dress to impress!
- Make sure you have good lighting. Film during the day and in a well lit room.
- If you use a phone, make sure you hold it horizontally.


