The General Assembly,

*Emphasizing* that 25% of global climate change can be traced to food<sup>1</sup>,

*Deeply concerned* that the levels of CO<sub>2</sub> in the atmosphere have increased by more than a third since the Industrial Revolution<sup>2</sup>,

*Alarmed by* growing amount of climate change refugees in island nations such as Kiribati<sup>3</sup>,

- 1) Calls upon the food industry to reduce the amount of meat production globally by 5% by 2025 while urging countries to discourage their citizens from eating meat;
- 2) Further invites governments to provide tax cuts to companies who reduce their emissions and develop products more energy efficiently;
- 3) Urges that governments provide alternative shelters for those who become displaced due to climate change.
