## 2021 Student Diplomat Jr. Model UN Creating a Placard

### What is a Placard?

- A placard identifies which country you are representing at the Model UN Conference.



### What is a Placard Used For?

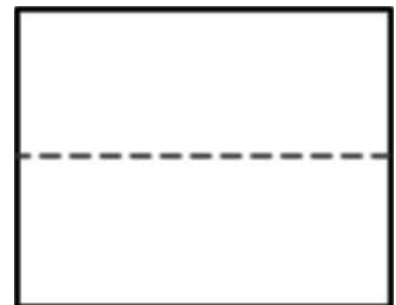
- During the Jr. Model UN Final Conference, you can use the placard to signal to the Chair that you would like to speak.
- You will use the placard to vote!
- And placards are very helpful in knowing which countries other students are representing.

### Materials You Need to Make a Placard:

- A blank piece of paper
- Writing utensils (markers, sharpies, colored pencils, or pens/pencils)

### How to Make a Placard:

- Fold your piece of paper in half lengthwise.
- Write the name of your country on both sides of the fold. Make sure to write in **large, bold letters.**



- Make sure you write the name of your country with the top of the letters next to the fold on both sides (See our example at the bottom!)

- Draw a picture of your country's flag next to the country name on both sides on the placard.

### **What Your Placard Should Include:**

- The name of your country
- Your country's flag
- Anything else you can think of to make your placard unique! Feel free to make your placard colorful and include drawings
  - Consider drawing pictures of famous landmarks or foods that are popular in your country
