ARRIVING AT OUR BUILDING AND LOCATING OUR OFFICE

The World Affairs Council of Philadelphia is located at One Penn Center in the Center City neighborhood. Our physical address is 1617 John F. Kennedy Blvd., Suite 1055, Philadelphia, PA 19103 (entrance on JFK Blvd. between 16th and 17th Street). The closest major landmarks include the Comcast Center, Suburban Station, Love Park, and City Hall.

When arriving at One Penn Center, guests are advised to sign in at the first-floor lobby. You will need to have a Photo ID prior to being granted access to the elevators to reach our suite, located on the tenth floor. Due to COVID-19 and security regulations, all guests must pre-register with staff ahead of time and a mandatory mask mandate is in place for visiting our office, regardless of vaccination status. If attending an in-person speaker event, pre-registration with staff separately is not required.



PARKING AND USING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Parking is available at any of the various Center City parking garages located near our building. In addition, street parking may be available on the adjacent blocks surrounding One Penn Center. We recommend using apps like Best Parking and Park Mobile to find the most up-to-date information on the best parking rates and information on parking availability.

Our office is easily accessible using public transportation (SEPTA) and our building is connected to Suburban Station, which connects to both regional and local rail lines. Many local bus lines also stop in Center City. Guests arriving at Suburban Station will have to exit to street level and walk a short distance to our office building on JFK Blvd. Visit www.septa.org for the most up-to-date information.
