This program offers a wonderful opportunity to experience Havana. The infrastructure of the city is good, with comfortable hotels, excellent restaurants, and a wide variety of educational and family oriented activities. You will be staying at the Parque Central, one of the best available hotels in Havana. Food in Havana is freshly prepared and we eat at delightful, privately owned local restaurants. More details will be provided upon registering for the trip.

Vaccinated participants must be in good health and able to keep up with an active group. In order to participate, one should be able to walk 1 mile comfortably, use stairs without handrails, and be able to walk and stand for periods of two hours at a time. Some days have an early-morning start and include a full day's schedule of activities, lectures, and special events. The temperature in the region during this time of the year is lovely, averaging in the upper 70s to low 80s (°F).

This program has been specially designed as a family-friendly program. We recommend this program for children over the age of 8.
