Terms: No credit for unused services. We reserve the right to levy a surcharge and/or change the itinerary if it becomes necessary. All meetings are subject to change due to unforeseen events. Substitute speakers with a similar background may participate with lead-in time permitting. You must be able to walk several city blocks as the bus is not always permitted to park within secure areas such as the Capitol.

Cancellation: A \$600 per person deposit is required to confirm your reservation. \$300 is refundable until 1/13/23. We sell trip cancellation insurance and strongly recommend its purchase.
