Friday, April 21 – Opening Speech Videos Due (Optional for Schools) Using their research skills, students record an opening speech video regarding their committee topic from the perspective of their assigned country. Faculty advisors and/or mentors review final resolutions and submit to Council staff via Google Drive. <i>This assignment is optional</i>. Friday, April 21 – Position Papers Due (Optional for Schools) Using their research skills, students write a position paper regarding their committee topic from the perspective of their assigned country. Faculty advisors and/or mentors review final resolutions and submit to Council staff via Google Drive. <i>This assignment is optional</i>.
May 2023	 Week of May 1 – Final Resolutions Available Council staff select and publish final resolutions for each committee. Students review drafts of final resolutions and practice public speaking and amendment writing skills in preparation for the Final Conference.
