



## United Nations Summer Camp

The **United Nations Summer Camp: *Access to Clean Water for All***, is a four-day summer camp for **middle school students** interested in learning about global affairs through the work of the United Nations. The program will give students an opportunity to participate in interactive expert briefings, games, and activities, while honing key skills and collaborating with their peers along the way. Participants will step into the shoes of diplomats as they work together to study the Sustainable Development Goals, learn public speaking tips and strategies, and make new friends while having fun! The Council's United Nations Summer Camp ends with a field trip to New York City including a tour of the United Nations. This program welcomes all students in grades 6-8, regardless of their familiarity with the United Nations or Model United Nations.
