YOUR ITINERARY

DAYS 1/2/3 ~ USA/KOCHI

CROWNE PLAZA KOCHI. (Meals Aloft; B,L,D)

Arrive early on Day 3 in Kochi, Kerala's vibrant seaside city known as "God's Own Country." After rest, visit the Dutch Palace with its Hindu epic murals, and the 16th-century Jewish Synagogue adorned with Chinese tiles. See the iconic Chinese fishing nets before enjoying a traditional Kathakali dance performance and dinner.

DAY 4 ~ KOCHI/ALLEPPEY/KUMARAKOM GOKULAM GRAND RESORT & SPA. (B,L,D)

Drive to Alleppey and board a traditional houseboat to cruise Kerala's serene backwaters. Drift past paddy fields, coconut groves, and village life unchanged for centuries. Watch fishermen, farmers, and floating markets along tranquil canals.

DAY 5 ~ KUMARAKOM GOKULAM GRAND RESORT & SPA. (B,L,D)

This morning, glide across Vembanad Lake to Manjira village on a Shikhara boat. Enjoy coconut climbing, taste local produce, and try weaving, coir-making, and fishing. Interact with villagers to experience authentic rural Kerala before returning to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at leisure, relaxing or exploring at your own pace.

DAY 6 ~ KUMARAKOM/KOCHI CROWNE PLAZA KOCHI. (B,L,D)

Drive back to Kochi through Kerala's scenic countryside. Attend scheduled meetings, then enjoy a leisurely afternoon exploring the city's history and culture before dinner.

DAY 7 ~ COCHIN/COLOMBO, SRI LANKA/ HABARANA

CINNAMON LODGE HABARANA. (B,L,D)

Fly to Colombo, then drive north along rolling coconut and rice fields. Enjoy lunch, and relax with a swim or garden stroll.

DAY 8 ~ HABARANA/SIGIRIYA/MINNERIYA CINNAMON LODGE HABARANA. (B,L,D)

Early this morning, drive to Sigiriya, one of Asia's greatest archaeological sites. Climb the iconic Lion's Rock Fortress for breathtaking views and explore its ancient frescoes and ruins, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Later, visit Polonnaruwa's well-preserved medieval temples and Buddha carvings. In the afternoon, enjoy a jeep safari in Minneriya National Park to spot wild elephants.

DAY 9 ~ HABARANA/DAMBULLA/KANDY KANDY MYST BY CINNAMON. (B,L,D)

This morning, drive to Dambulla to visit the UNESCO-listed Cave Temple, famed for its murals and 130 Buddha statues. Continue to Kandy to see the Sacred Tooth Relic Temple, then visit Asgiriya Monastery for a blessing ceremony. Conclude the day with afternoon tea at the historic Queens Hotel.

DAYS 10/11 ~ KANDY/NUWARA ELIYA/HORTON PLAINS

JETWING ST. ANDREWS. (B,L,D; B,PACKED L,D)

Travel to Nuwara Eliya, a charming hill town shaped by British colonial heritage and famed as the heart of Ceylon Tea Land. Founded by Sir Samuel Baker in 1846, this "Little England" features cool mountain air, colonial architecture, flower gardens, and rolling green hills. Next day, depart for Horton Plains, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and beautiful plateau in Sri Lanka's central highlands. Explore rolling grasslands, misty forests, and landmarks like World's End and Baker's Fall. Home to sambar deer and purplefaced langurs, this tranquil park offers breathtaking views and peaceful hiking trails. The rest of your day is at leisure.

DAYS 12/13/14 ~ NUWARA ELIYA/COLOMBO/USA CINNAMON LIFE. (B,L,D; B,L, Meals Aloft)

This morning, drive to Colombo. Relax this afternoon, then gather for sundowners and a farewell dinner at the Galle Face Hotel, one of Asia's oldest and most iconic landmarks. Next morning, attend scheduled meetings and visit the American Embassy before exploring Colombo's highlights. Visit Fort, Pettah Bazaar, and landmarks like the Jumi Ul Alfar Mosque, Dutch Church, Cinnamon Gardens, and Independence Square. Your room will be available until departure. Later, transfer to the airport for your flight home.


